Materials

Ask for detailed information on materials, including their durability, lifespan, and warranty.



Cost

Discuss the cost of different materials and their impact on the overall budget.



Permit and Inspection Process: Streamlined Project

Inquire whether they handle permits and inspections, ensuring compliance with regulations.

Clarify their process for obtaining permits, scheduling inspections, and communicating updates.
